#### **Book Review Style Guide**

Please format the heading of your review as

Book Title

Author's last name, Author's first name

City of publication, Press name, Year of publication

Reviewer's Name  
University of Professional Affiliation

Book reviews should be at least 600 words in length and no more than 1,000. Please edit your review to conform to this length. Reviews may be edited based on space considerations.

Reviews must include the following elements: a summary of the book's main argument(s), organization, use of evidence, and conclusion(s). Please also include a discussion of the work's significance, its contribution to the historiography, and its overall value to various audiences. It is not necessary to critique typographical errors or similar, superficial flaws unless they are of a character or quantity that detracts from the overall presentation or the argument.

Please note where the author succeeded as well as where they fell short of your expectations. Offer constructive suggestions for how the author (or future authors) could improve. Always remain professional and respectful.

Be Sure to cite all quotations in parentheses following the relevant sentence or passage. Please limit the inclusion of outside books and articles beyond simple historiographical references. If you choose to include references and quotes from outside works, please include a complete citation, including page number(s), in a footnote. Please do **not** include block quotes in your review.

Reviews should be written in 12-point font, Times New Roman. Please align left and double-space the text.

Do not use contractions. Avoid using the passive voice when possible.

Please email your completed review in an attachment using Microsoft Word, Google Docs, or an equivalent. Please do **not** send reviews as a PDF or in the body of the email.

Reviews will be edited to remove errors that detract from the review's overall clarity. Examples include passive voice, typos, comma splices, subject-verb agreement, incorrect quotations, overly long quotations, etc.
